Some helpful tips for Jacket STING:

Below is a recap for the graduation requirements for our students. Please go over these with your kids and keep this sheet for your reference.

→ English (4 credits)— English I, II, III, IV

→ Math (4 credits)—

- # Alg 1, Geometry, Alg 2, and 4th Math with Alg 2 as prerequisite *(2009-2011)* -- or—
- # Math 1, Math 2, Math 3, and 4th Math with Math 3 as prerequisite *(2012 and beyond)*
- *#* The classes we teach which satisfy the 4th level are : Discrete math, Advanced Functions and Modeling, Advanced Functions and Modeling **Honors**, and Honors Pre-Calculus

 Science (3 credits)— Earth & Environmental Science, Biology, and Chemistry <u>or</u> Physical Science

→ Social Studies - (4 credits)

- World History, Civics/Econ, <u>and</u> American History 1 + American History 2 ----- OR-----
- World History, Civics/Econ, AP U.S. History, and an additional Social Studies Elective
- Health/PE (1 credit of H/PE)
- → <u>2 Elective Combination:</u> (2 credits)
- ✓ Can be any combination of CTE, Arts Education, or World Languages
- ✓ Example- Spanish 1 & Spanish 2 / Theatre 1 & Visual Arts 1 / Personal Finance & Marketing / Metals 1 & Concert Choir

Students must have 2 credits in a foreign language for minimum admission requirements to UNC Universities- NOT to graduate high school

→ <u>4 Credit Concentration/ Cluster</u>

- The 4 credit concentration must be classes of the same area of academic interest
 ***** Example: JR0TC 1,2,3& 4 / Theatre 1,2,3,4 / 4 AP Classes / Speech & Debate 1 and 2, Journalism 1 and 2
- To be considered a <u>CLUSTER</u>, The 4 classes MUST from the designated cluster classes from the lists on pages 15-31. A Cluster must have a completer course (designated by *) and 3 more credits (no more than 1 enhancement course)

***** Example: Core Sustainable Construction, Carpentry 1, Masonry 1, and Masonry 2 = Architecture & Construction
